

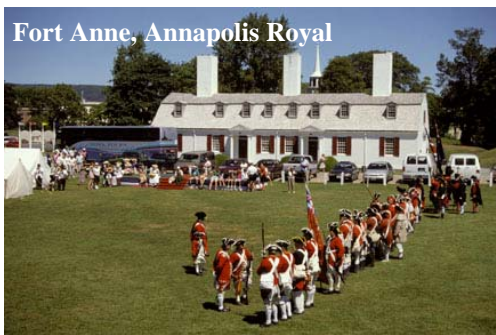

*What you'll find:*

▲ Forty-foot tides at Hall's Harbour that create a scene of remarkable transformations, twice a day. Visit seafood restaurants, museums, art galleries and studios, while scoping out the best places to take photos.

▲ Grand Pré National Historic Site marks one of the locations of the Deportation of the Acadians in 1755 and its traditional, formal gardens that boast 14 acres of beautifully groomed perennials and annuals.

▲ The Domaine de Grand Pré Winery where you can mix business with pleasure. Stroll through vineyards or host a relaxing outdoor reception among the pergola columns. Add in a winery tour and visit the wine shop to take a taste of Domaine de Grand Pré home with you.

▲ Annapolis Royal, the oldest European settlement in Canada (est. 1605) and home to a host of historic attractions including Fort Anne (Canada's first National Historic Park), Annapolis Royal Historic Gardens, King's Theatre, numerous historic buildings, monuments and museums. You will also find North America's first tidal power generating station that harnessed the phenomenal power of the Bay of Fundy tides.
